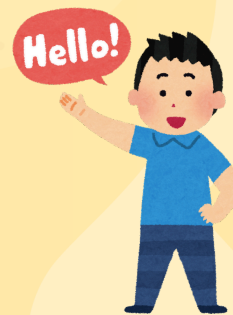

Reading Levels

1

Recognizing uppercase/lowercase letters, phonics sounds, blending, segmenting, CVC words, , and short phrases.

2

Double-letter words, long vowels, consonant blends, 4-5 letter words, short sentences, and book features.

3

Short sentences with 3-5 letter words and sight words

4

Vowel digraphs, silent letters, consonant blends, 5-6 letter words, sight words, short sentences, wordless picture stories, and decodable stories.

5

6-7 letter words, silent letters, irregular vowel digraphs, and understanding the main idea in a 50-60 word paragraph.

6

Read a 100-word passage, identify key details, describe characters and events using a story map, and make inferences from the text.

7

Read a 150-word passage and express opinions on characters, actions, and events.

8

Read a 200-word passage, analyze plot, characters, and events, and make inferences from multiple details.



Writing Levels

1

Write uppercase and lowercase letters, and express ideas or events through simple drawings.

2

Spell and write 2-3 letter words, express thoughts and emotions through drawings, and label objects.

3

Spell 2-4 letter words, express thoughts and emotions through drawings, and label objects.

4

Write short words and phrases from dictation, and create simple stories using picture sequences with brief text.

5

Use basic punctuation in short sentences and create fantasy stories through pictures.

6

Express ideas through pictures, photos, and short descriptions; edit and proofread written work.

7

Write a structured paragraph expressing opinions with an introduction, supporting reasons, and linking words (*ex : because, and , also, therefore*)

8

Write short paragraphs of 100-150 words / write a short poem.



Grammar Levels

1

Frequently used nouns, personal pronouns (*singular*) and basic prepositions.

2

Personal pronouns (*plural*), frequently occurring prepositions and question words.

3

Learn common nouns, present tense verbs, personal pronouns, and question words through stories, songs, poems, and discussions.

4

Learn possessive pronouns, regular verbs in past tense (-ed), and common adjectives and adverbs through stories and activities.

5

Learn possessive nouns, subject-verb agreement in simple sentences, and verbs to express past, present, and future.

6

Use a variety of adjectives, adverbs, and prepositions; connect ideas with conjunctions; make comparisons; and form simple and compound sentences.

7

Learn collective nouns, determiners, irregular plurals, and irregular verb tenses. Practice subject-verb agreement and form simple and compound sentences using irregular verbs.

8

Form and expand sentences in declarative, interrogative, imperative, and exclamatory forms. Use simple, compound, and complex sentences with reflexive pronouns, adjectives, and adverbs.



Speaking Levels

1

Alphabet, songs, rhymes, and answering simple yes/no questions.

2

Answer basic questions, give simple reasons, describe objects briefly, listen, and categorize.

3

Respond to Wh- and Why questions, give simple reasons, and briefly describe objects.

4

Use short expressions, simple present and past tense, and narrate events in sequence with basic time words.

5

Use simple sentences, idioms, phrasal verbs, and collocations. Engage in social exchanges and give a structured 100-word talk on a topic.

6

Ask and answer factual and inferential questions, and narrate a 100-150 word sequence of events.

7

Engage in short conversations, express ideas with varied vocabulary, and speak on informational topics with a structured introduction, details, and conclusion.

8

Give directions, compare and contrast, describe daily situations, and narrate stories with key elements.
